

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-0912

**AN ORDINANCE REGARDING ISSUANCE OF
OPERATORS' LICENSES IN THE TOWN OF SPRING VALLEY**

WHEREAS, the Town of Spring Valley has the authority to issue Operators' licenses for the sale of alcohol pursuant to §125.17 of the Wisconsin Statutes; and

WHEREAS, whereas the Town has the authority to issue Operators' licenses for a period of one year or two years; and

WHEREAS, the Town has the authority to designate a Town official to issue provisional licenses; and

WHEREAS, the Town has the authority to set fees applicable to the processing of applications for Operators' licenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Spring Valley do hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION I: Operators' licenses issued by the Town of Spring Valley pursuant to §125.17, Stats., shall be valid for 2 years and shall expire on the first June 30 following the first full year of licensure (regardless of the specific date of issuance).

SECTION II: The Town Clerk is authorized to issue provisional operators' licenses, subject to the following standards:


- a) The applicant shall submit a completed operator's license application to the Town Clerk.
- b) The applicant shall authorize the release of personal criminal information to the Town of Spring Valley.
- c) The applicant shall be enrolled in a responsible beverage service training course.
- d) A provisional operator's license may not be issued to any person who has been denied a license under §125.17(1), Wis. Stats., by the Town Board of the Town of Spring Valley.
- e) The provisional operator's license shall expire 60 days after its issuance or when an operator's license under §125.17(1), Wis. Stats., is issued to the holder, whichever is sooner.
- f) The provisional operator's license shall be revoked if it is discovered that the holder of the license made a false statement on the application or if the personal criminal information is determined to be unfavorable for a person holding an operator's license.

SECTION III: The fees for an operator's license and a provisional operator's license shall be set by resolution of the Town Board and may be amended from time to time. A current fee schedule, including any fees to be charged for background checks, shall be maintained on file with the Town Clerk.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.
