A recycling truck will be in the parking lot of the Rock County Public Works building at the corner of State Road 213 and Tollefson Road just north of Orfordville.

Advanced Disposal's SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING makes it EASY!

All recycling material can be brought in unsorted. Items to recycle include:

NEWSPAPERS, MAGAZINES, OFFICE PAPERS

Glossy inserts, catalogs, mail circulars, phone books, paperback books, envelopes, wrapping paper, etc.

CARDBOARD (FLATTENED)

Clean cardboard only, broken down and flattened.

GLASS (CLEAR, BROWN, GREEN)

All bottles and jars must be rinsed out. NO window glass, light bulbs, drinking glass, etc.

ALUMINUM BEVERAGE CANS only.

No aluminum foil, baking pans, etc.

TIN & BI-METAL CANS

Soup, vegetable, juice cans, etc. Must be rinsed.

PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Must be rinsed out completely. Plastic bottles and jars with the recycling symbols 1 through 5 and 7.

Look for the coding on bottom of the bottle.

NO Styrofoam or deli, butter, microwave, motor oil, antifreeze, or pesticide/herbicide containers.

NO medical waste, yard waste, wet paint or hazardous materials!

Electronic equipment to recycle? Can't make it to recycling drop-off day?

Your regular recyclables, plus small electronic equipment, may be dropped off at Advanced Disposal's (formerly Rock Disposal) operational site at 2301 W. BR Townline Rd., Beloit, WI, weekdays from 8:00a.m.-3:00p.m. Please stop at the office to confirm your Spring Valley residency.

Large electronic items (TV's, etc.) should be taken to URT, 2535 Beloit Ave., Janesville, WI.
